UPDATE

Since the conclusion of the final hearing of the Inquiry last December, the Chairman of the

Inquiry, the Rt. Hon. Sir Jonathan Parker, has been drafting his Report into the issues raised

by the Inquiry's Terms of Reference.

As the Chairman explained in the course of the final hearing of the Inquiry, anyone who

provided evidence to the Inquiry, and who is the subject of adverse criticism in the draft

Report, will be given an opportunity to respond to, or otherwise to comment on, such adverse

criticism before the Report is finally signed off.

That stage has now been reached, and letters are being sent to relevant persons inviting

responses and/or comments by no later than the end of October.

The Chairman will consider any such responses or comments before finalising the Report and

presenting it to the Government as required by the Inquiry's Terms of Reference.
